**ANNOUNCEMENT
CHANGE OF CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER**

Mapletree Logistics Trust Management Ltd. ("**Manager**"), as manager of Mapletree Logistics Trust ("**MapletreeLog**"), wishes to announce the following key management changes with effect from 1 May 2010:

1. the resignation of Mr Chua Tiow Chye as Chief Executive Officer of the Manager, whereupon Mr Chua Tiow Chye will remain as a Non-Executive Director of the Manager;
2. the appointment of Mr Richard Lai (currently Deputy Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer of the Manager) as Chief Executive Officer and Executive Director of the Manager; and
3. the appointment of Ms Wong Mei Lian as Chief Financial Officer of the Manager.

Mr Chua Tiow Chye will relinquish his role as Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer of the Manager to focus on his role as Chief Investment Officer of MapletreeLog's sponsor, Mapletree Investments Pte Ltd ("**Sponsor**"). He will nonetheless continue to guide MapletreeLog as a Non-Executive Director of the Manager.

Mr Richard Lai has been with the Manager since February 2005 as Chief Financial Officer (wherein he played a key role in the preparations for MapletreeLog's Initial Public Offering ("**IPO**") in July 2005) and became Deputy Chief Executive Officer in June 2007. He has extensive investment banking experience prior to joining the Manager. Mr Richard Lai started his banking career in 1992 with Arab-Malaysian Merchant Bank Berhad (now AmlInvestment Bank Berhad) in Malaysia and thereafter with Schroder International as well as Standard Chartered Bank Malaysia Berhad as Head of Structured Products and subsequently Director of Debt Capital Markets, and with Alliance Merchant Bank Berhad as Director of Investment Banking. He is a member of Malaysia Mensa Society and has a Bachelor of Economics (Honours) with a major in Accounting and Finance from the University of Manchester (UK).

Ms Wong Mei Lian is Senior Vice President (Treasury) of the Sponsor since November 2007. Prior to joining the Sponsor, Ms Wong Mei Lian has been responsible for treasury and corporate finance activities during previous positions held with CapitaLand group of companies and subsequently as Head of Treasury of Singapore Power Ltd. She has more than 15 years of work experience in diverse areas including investment banking, corporate finance and treasury and real estate financial products. Earlier in her career, Ms Wong gained extensive experience in debt capital markets whilst working for the merchant banking arm of Schrodgers where she was involved in the origination, structuring and syndication of debt in South East Asia. Ms Wong holds a Bachelor of Business Administration from the National University of Singapore.

These changes in key management personnel are part of succession planning for the Manager and would further enhance the depth of its management bench capabilities. It will enable MapletreeLog to continue to grow from strength to strength, as manifested by the results of MapletreeLog since IPO (in this regard, MapletreeLog has delivered a total return of 55% for its unitholders who have held units in MapletreeLog from IPO to 31 December 2009).

The detailed announcements pursuant to Rule 704(7) of the Listing Manual on the change of appointment for Mr Chua Tiow Chye and the appointments of Mr Richard Lai and Ms Wong Mei Lian are being released separately.
